DAY 1: TUE NOV 7 - DEPARTURE USA

Depart North America via jet service. Dinner and breakfast will be served on board.

DAY 2: WED NOV 8 - ARRIVAL / TEL AVIV / NETANYA On arrival in Tel Aviv we will be met by your representative and transferred to our accommodations in Tel Aviv/ Netanya where our dinner will be served. Overnight at Hotel.

Breakfast at the Hotel. This morning we begin with a boat ride on The Sea of Galilee. We will visit a replica of a fishing boat from the time of Christ. Our visit continues to the Mt. of Beatitudes to gain a panoramic view of the Sea of Galilee.

At 11:00am we celebrate Mass at Mt.

Beatitudes Church (TBC).

We will visit Tabgha where it is believed that Jesus fed the crowd of 5,000. From there we will visit Capernaum where Jesus began his Galilean ministry, visiting the synagogue which dates to the time of Jesus and the site of Peter's home and enjoy a St. Peter's Fish Lunch (TBC).

DAY 6: SUN NOV 12 - JORDAN VALLEY / JERICHO / **DEAD SEA**

Breakfast and check out. We continue throughout the Jordan Valley where Jesus walked with His disciples, we stop at the baptismal site on the banks of the Jordan River, Qasr al-Yahud. Then we head to Jericho to view, from a distance, the Mt. of Temptation now home to a Greek Orthodox Monastery and to see the traditional sycamore tree of Zacchaeus. Our last stop is at The little village of Bethany, on the eastern slope of the Mount of Olives about 3km from Jerusalem it was a favorite place of rest and refuge for Jesus. Here he knew the friendship of his friends Martha, Mary and Lazarus. Here, in the cemetery just below the village, he raised Lazarus from the dead. Then transfer to the Dead Sea, check in dinner and overnight at hotel.

DAY 7: MON NOV 13 - DEAD SEA / QUMRAN / **BETHANY / JERUSALEM**

Breakfast, we drive to Qumran, site of the discovery of the Dead Sea Scrolls. We stop to view the Dead Sea, the lowest point on earth and optional swim in the salty water. We visit Qumran and Bethany.

At 14:00pm we celebrate Mass at Bethany Church – Bethany, then transfer to Jerusalem for check in, dinner and overnight at our hotel.

DAY 08: TUES NOV 14 - BETHLEHEM DAY

This morning we begin our day with breakfast at the Hotel. Followed by a visit to the Shepherds, and at 11:00 am we celebrate Mass at Shepherd's Field / The Big Grotto (01st Altar) (TBC).

We then will visit the Church of the Nativity, St. Wood & Mother-of-Pearl Gifts in Bethlehem. Then back to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

DAY 9: WED NOV 15 - JERUSALEM / MOUNT OF
